Jones (indisposed), Mrs P. M. Jones (no reason given), D. W. Lee (work commitment), W. N. Tasker (other commitment), G. Williams (family illness)

150. AMENDMENTS TO AGENDA

In accordance with Standing Order No. 14 a Member requested that given that no Press or Members of the Public were present and due to the size of the Agenda, that the confidential items on the Agenda be brought forward so as to ensure and enable thorough debate

RESOLVED accordingly

A Member indicated that he had received informal advice from the Monitoring Officer suggested that dispensation to those Members who were also members of the Rhyl Community Association to speak and vote on this item might be available from the County Council Standards Committee and in the circumstances he sought a deferment of the item. The Town Clerk commented that in the circumstances it was advisable to defer the item to a future date.

RESOLVED that the above item be deferred until receipt of the Monitoring Officer's advice in relation to possible dispensations being granted prior to consideration.

Councillor G. J. Pickering asked that it be noted that he as Chairman of the Rhyl Community Association Working Group had not been informed prior to the meeting of any advice being sought from the Monitoring Officer.

151. EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

RESOLVED that the Press and Public be excluded from the Meeting for consideration of the following items of business in accordance with Section 1(2) of the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act, 1960, on the grounds of confidentiality.

152. RHYL IN BLOOM

The Town Clerk presented his confidential report which included the final report from the Town Council's Wales in Bloom Project Management Team (circulated with Agenda) and noted the decisions and expenditure it had undertaken on behalf of the Council.

Two Members of the Project Management Team referred to the significant community effort and success of the Town in gaining a silver merit for it's entry and thanked all involved for their time and commitment.

RESOLVED that the reports be received.

153. REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY PRODUCTION

The Town Clerk submitted his confidential report (circulated with Agenda) seeking approval to produce and distribute a commemorative DVD of the 2008 event and including a suggested distribution list for the DVD. Costs identified would be met from the Civic budget.

RESOLVED that the report be approved.

154. DRAFT BUDGET 2010/2011

The Town Clerk and Finance Officer submitted for Members' consideration, their joint report (copy of confidential Draft Budget and accompanying statements circulated with Agenda), providing budget monitoring information for the current financial year and seeking to determine the Council's Budget, Management and Operational Plan and precept for the financial year 2010/2011 and indicating:

- (i) that the Council was required to approve a balanced revenue budget;
- (ii) that the figures presented would necessitate levying a precept of £400,000 or otherwise the Committee could determine a lower figure provided that they also identified corresponding savings from the revenue budget;
- (iii) that additionally, other limited reserves within the Community Development Fund were available to support the Council's

prioritised projects details of which were set out within Appendix A and B of the report;

The Finance Officer responded to several questions put by Members.

In response to a Member's question, the Town Clerk confirmed that unfortunately Denbighshire County Council had not advised the Town Council of its own budget proposals, despite this information being promised at a meeting he and the Mayor had had with the Leader and Chief Executive in August 2009. Therefore it had not been possible to account for any foreseeable implications.

The report identified that a Precept of £400,000 was equivalent to a 3.2% average increase per week in Council Tax per household for Town Council services.

Members were conscious that this level of Precept in the current financial climate might not be received well and considered a number of budgets where savings could be made to reduce the necessary Precept.

Following discussion a counter proposal Precept of £395,000 and a reduction of £5,000 in the grants budget was put forward as an amendment, but was not carried.

The report identified a number of specific items requiring decisions and it was **RESOLVED** that:

- a) the probable figures for 2009/10 and the Budget figures for 2010/11 be approved as set out in Appendix D
- b) the existing expenditure commitments and indicative allocations for the Community Development Programme be noted as set out in Appendix A and B.
- c) with regard to the South West / East Rhyl Renewal Area study to be undertaken by Denbighshire County Council a contribution of £8,000 be made.
- d) with regard to the Enforcement of Environment Crime initiative managed by Denbighshire County Council no contribution be made.
- e) the appointment of the Internal Auditor for work related to the financial year 2010/11 be approved.
- f) the Balances Policy Statement be approved as stated "Following approval of the Budget and Precept for the financial year 2010/11 the projected level of revenue balances as at 31st March 2011 will be circa £140,000 and considered in aggregate with the Council's other expenditure commitments and proposals from its Community

Development Programme are deemed appropriate for an authority of this size".

- g) the Town Council's Investment Strategy as set out in Appendix F of the report be approved.
- h) authority for the Town Clerk to act with regard to the Budget and Community Development Programme to spend such sums as approved without further reference back, be confirmed.
- i) the Council levies a precept of £400,000 (Four Hundred Thousand Pounds) upon Denbighshire County Council for the financial year commencing on 1st April 2010, Denbighshire County Council to be advised accordingly.

[Prior to consideration of allocating funds to the South West / East Rhyl Renewal Area scheme, Councillor D. A. J. Thomas declared a prejudicial interest due to the scheme falling under his portfolio as a Denbighshire County Council Cabinet Member, and vacated the Chair and Chamber, taking no further part in discussion or voting thereon]

[Vice-Chair, Councillor Mrs M. McCarroll, took the Chair for the remainder of that particular discussion]

155. COASTAL HAWKS PROJECT

The Finance Officer submitted his confidential report for Members' consideration (circulated with Agenda), regarding an application for financial support towards a new project within the town with a planned launch date of 1st March.

The application had previously been deferred by the Committee pending receipt of the Project Business Plan, and from the papers now provided, the Finance Officer explained the nature of the project and the figures set out therein.

Members expressed support for the Project which they agreed was innovative and had several worthy objectives.

RESOLVED that a contribution of £3,782 be made to the Project subject to:

- (a) receipt of regular quarterly progress reports to the Town Council.
- (b) due recognition of the Town Council's support being made in promotional literature, web site and press releases, etc.

<u>FURTHER RESOLVED</u> that Standing Orders be suspended to enable the Town Clerk to act as a matter of urgency.

[Councillors Mrs L. M. Edwards and M. C. Espley declared a prejudicial interest in the above item due to their position as Project Directors and vacated the Chamber, taking no further part in discussion or voting thereon]

[A five minute comfort break was taken at this point after which the meeting resumed in open session]

156. DENBIGHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL - LOCAL SERVICE BOARD

Further to Minute No.82 of the meeting held on 21st October 2009 (Minute Extract circulated with Agenda) Councillor M. C. Espley reported that he and Councillor I. A. Gunning had attended the event on 3rd November 2009 and that it had been born out of a requirement to review community strategies in Rhyl. Councillor Espley advised that the day was workshop based with Denbighshire County Council officers manning stalls with a 'Vision of Change in Denbighshire' theme and was an enjoyable and useful event.

The only negative that he could see was that there was no 'youth' involvement. However, he added that when he raised this he was assured that future consultations would include representation from local youth groups.

RESOLVED that the report be received.

157. FINANCIAL REGULATIONS AND STANDING ORDERS

The Town Clerk and the Finance Officer submitted their joint report relating to amendments to the Town Council's Financial Regulations and Standing Orders (circulated with Agenda). The report identified that changes to the documents had been necessary in the light of legal, proper practice guidance and Code of Conduct issues and had all been considered and approved by the Risk Assessment Sub-Committee.
