### 177. CROWN POST OFFICE

Further to Minute No.168 of the meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2013, the Town Clerk presented his report (circulated with Agenda) detailing the enquiries he had made following the recent press reports relating to the possible closure and relocation of Rhyl's Main Post Office.

Members advised that they had heard a number of rumours about potential relocation sites in the town centre and of wage cuts for Post Office staff.
