## 87. ANNUAL BUDGET

The Town Clerk referred to the Finance and General Purposes Committee's report (circulated with agenda) and recommendations contained therein, unchanged since its last meeting on 6<sup>th</sup> December 2017.

The Town Clerk did however report one notable change since the report had been written, which was that the council tax base figure for 2018/19 had increased from 9,298 to 9,367 properties, lowering the necessary increase to the precept from 4.5% to approximately 3.7%.

## **RESOLVED** that the Council
