1. OPENING OF MEETING & APOLOGIES

The Mayor's Chaplain, Father Charles Ramsay, commenced proceedings by leading all those wishing to take part, in prayer.

The Mayor welcomed all to the meeting, particularly the newly elected councillor for the Brynhedydd ward, Mrs M. A. Walker and all civic and personal guests.

2. ELECTION OF MAYOR AND INSTALLATION
