

Rhyl Town Council has unwrapped a whole host of treats and activities for Christmas.

From competitions to choirs and with a free film too, there are 12 days of activities and competitions for people in Rhyl to get involved with and enjoy.

The Christmas countdown gets underway on December 1 with a performance by the Ghostbuskers Community Choir in the town centre. There is also a sporting theme to this year's activities with the chance for a special youngster to be Rhyl Football Club's mascot and drop-in, have-a-go- sessions with Rhyl Table Tennis Club who will be setting up in the White Rose.

Topping the billing will be a free film showing of the Christmas classic It's a Wonderful Life at Rhyl Town Hall with 250 tickets being given away.

Rhyl Mayor, Cllr Sarah Roberts, said the town council's Christmas offer had something for everyone.

Cllr Roberts said: "Our Christmas programme is all about spreading festive cheer throughout our town. We have talented local singers and musicians lined up for the town centre, competitions for people of all ages to get involved in, meet-and-greets with characters from the Disney hit Frozen and much more.

"The star on top of our Christmas tree will be the free showing of It's a Wonderful Life on December 17 with 250 free tickets being given away from December 7."

The town council has joined forces with Old Colwyn-based TAPE Community Arts Charity to stage the film at Rhyl Town Hall.

"Our Christmas activities are about supporting as much of the town as we can – from the town centre to our local clubs and schools.

"By joining forces with Rhyl FC and Rhyl Table Tennis Club we are showing there are activities in the town for people to go out and join, that there are things for people to do. After all, who can't resist having a go at a little Ping Pong Merrily High on High," added Cllr Roberts.
